## Fun Facts About Walt Disney World

- 1 In the Disney theme park *Disney World* the ride "The Tower of Terror" has fake grave stones into which workers have engraved their names.
- 2 The *Animal Kingdom* theme park is approximately six hundred acres.
- 3 The *Walt Disney World* theme park was forced to close on Sept. 15, due to hurricane Floyd. This marked the first time in its twenty-eight year history that the WDW parks were closed.
- 4 The *Magic Kingdom* can hold up to 100,000 people.
- 5 On January 1, 1978, *Treasure Island* changed its name to *Discovery Island*.
- 6 About fifteen kids get lost each day in the *Magic Kingdom* and are found by workers who find their parents.
- 7 The movie "Lilo and Stitch" includes six of Elvis's biggest hits including "Hound Dog".
- 8 On July 1987, total attendance topped two hundred and fifty million.
- 9 Walt wanted to name Mickey Mouse Mortimer, but his wife convinced him to use the name "Mickey."
- 10 Robin Williams and Steve Martin were both sailors at one time for the Jungle Cruise in *Disney Land*.
- 11 *Walt Disney World* operates four theme parks with a total of one hundred and two attractions.
- 12 Before *The Lion King* came out the original name was *King of the Jungle*.

# TIPS FOR COLLECTING AND TALLYING YODER'S RECEIPTS

## Due June 4 and 5, 2007

- 1.) Make sure the register receipts have **Yoder's Market** or **Yoder's Pharmacy** on the receipt, only these Yoder's receipts will be accepted. **Sorry, we cannot accept receipts of payments made on Yoder's charge accounts, Gas Island, Gift Shop or Petal Perfect.**
- 2.) Make sure the dates on the receipts are within the dates we are collecting the receipts, (i.e. 4/01/07-5/31/07) any other dates will not be accepted.
- 3.) Original receipts only, no photocopies
- 4.) Please do not highlight subtotals as it smears the ink and makes it difficult to verify.
- 5.) Tally the receipts..... **Use the subtotal after discounts, coupons and adjustments and before tax**...(see an example below), fill out slip below and turn in the receipts on specified collection dates to the container marked for receipts in the band room..... **(NOT THE WHITE PAYMENT BOX)**
- 6.) **Due to deadlines we will not be able to take late turn-ins.**
